WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS:

A splendid wine, deep dark ruby, ideally calibrated with nuances of cherry, cinnamon and earthy notes. Its medium body is enhanced by ripe mulberries, anise, tobacco and distinctive mineral remarks that only mountain grapes are able to offer. Perfectly balanced and vibrant finish, well-shaped round tannins with an acidity that ends in a delicious soft melody that runs through the palate smoothly.

GROWING SEASON:

2014 was one of the warmest and driest vintages on record, Napa Valley certainly experienced the effects of the drought. There was no frost during bud break which contributed to a strong, early set in the vineyard. Warm days and no rain allowed us to harvest a beautiful crop in early weeks of August.

LONG MEADOW RANCH:

Owned by Ted, Laddie, and Christopher Hall, LMR employs an integrated, organic farming system, using simple, sustainable methods. Each part of the Ranch contributes to the health of the whole. Vineyards and wine making, olive orchards and olive oil making, cattle and horse breeding all work together in complementary fashion, as do the egg-laying poultry flock and the organic vegetable gardens. All crops are certified organic by California Certified Organic Farmers (CCOF) and are grown without the use of herbicides, pesticides, or chemical fertilizers.
