GROWING SEASON:

"The Vintage of a Lifetime"

In 2023 Napa Valley experienced one of the longest growing seasons in over a decade. With consistent, mild weather, above-average crop yields, and extended hang time, the 2023 vintage is an exceptional, high-quality, and memorable vintage. Winter and spring rains led to full reservoirs and healthy, saturated soils – ideal conditions as grape growers headed into bud break. The mild, warm summer weather that followed supported healthy canopy growth through bloom and set. Relatively cool weather throughout the growing season in tandem with an abundance of sunshine allowed grape skins to ripen slowly and develop maximal color components. Harvest kicked off around Labor Day Weekend for white wine grapes. Cabernet Sauvignon harvest started in early October which provided extended hang time to develop flavors. Wines from this vintage are fresh, elegant, and have an overall purity about them.

LONG MEADOW RANCH:

Owned by Ted, Laddie, and Christopher Hall, LMR employs an integrated, organic farming system, using simple, sustainable methods. Each part of the Ranch contributes to the health of the whole. Vineyards and wine making, olive orchards and olive oil making, cattle and horse breeding all work together in complementary fashion, as do the egg-laying poultry flock and the organic vegetable gardens. All crops are certified organic by California Certified Organic Farmers (CCOF) and are grown without the use of herbicides, pesticides, or chemical fertilizers.
